## About Men's Group

Men's Group is for males who would like to enjoy social or leisure opportunities within the local area that.

The program provides an opportunity to network socially with other men that are living independently. Individual preferences and choices are built into the program so the participants get the most from their trips

A short bus trip is taken to places of interest within a 50km radius of Albury fortnightly on a Wednesday (a quarterly program is available from Age Concern).

The cost for each trip is \$35.00, this includes the bus fare and lunch at a suitable venue.

Some activities or entertainment may also be provided if available.



## How Does It Work?

- \* Participants are picked up and returned to their homes by bus.
- \* The return trip usually takes approximately 6 hours.
- \* Assistance to get on and off the bus is available if required.
- \* One of the buses is fitted with a wheelchair lifter should it be required.
- \* Volunteer helpers also assist if necessary during the outing.

The program may be varied to include barbeques and visits local places of interest, etc.
